

VETERANS AWARD INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

The MI-CAPP Education Foundation Committee presents the "Veterans Award" application packet for college <u>level</u> TRIO/EOP students. The committee may award two **\$1000** awards to nominated students for your projects at the Student Leadership Summit Scholarship Banquet. Project Directors will register student scholarship recipients for the Full Saturday February 27, 2020 conference and ensure they attend the Student Leadership Summit Scholarship Banquet.

Project Directors, nominators, and readers must be MI-CAPP members by December 4, 2020.

Who can apply?

Adult Veterans Learners: In a TRIO Program for at least one year.

Instructions

- 1. All application packets will be available in <u>electronic form only</u> on the MI-CAPP website <u>www.micapp.org</u>
- 2. Students/staff <u>must complete</u> the application packet electronically and apply via email by Friday, December 4, 2020.
- 3. All electronic application documents and supplemental materials: application, recommendation, essay, and the transcript must be emailed as ONE attachment to the MI-CAPP EFC email address micapp-scholarship@eoa.org
- 4. Any project submitting scholarship application packets must agree to designate at least one (1) reader **from its project.** Readers responsibilities are reading and scoring scholarships, submitting scores electronically and participating in the reading meeting.
- 5. To ensure inclusion in the Scholarship Banquet program booklet, if the applicant is selected, please be prepared to e-mail a jpeg photograph and 150-word bio to Yadira Bautista micapp-scholarship@eoa.org as soon as notified of selection.
- 6. Directors will be notified of winners following the scholarship reading and board approval. Directors will be expected to submit the winner's jpeg photograph, 150-word bio and photo release at this time.
- 7. If an applicant's application is selected for an EOA Scholarship, additional forms must be completed. Forms will be dispersed as needed later.

Applications will be disqualified if:

- 1. They are emailed after Friday, December 4, 2020.
- 2. MI-CAPP memberships not active on Friday, December 4, 2020 (as verified by the EOA Registrar).
- 3. The Project Director does not sign (typed name is acceptable) the application.
- 4. The electronic application is edited from its original format.
- 5. The final application packet does not include all required documents.
- 6. The applicant is found to be ineligible for TRIO/EOP service, and admission date to the current program did not fall on or before the appropriate date. (December 4, 2019)
- 7. The applicant is not registered for the full Saturday Student Leadership Conference.



VETERANS AWARD GUIDELINES

- 1. The Applicant's Personal Essay should include the following information:
 - The impact of TRIO or educational opportunity program on your education
 - A specific description of your plan to obtain your baccalaureate degree
 - Why the MI-CAPP Veterans Scholarship is important to you
- 2. The Nominator's Recommendation should include the following two-part information:

Evaluation Grid Portion

• Describe the applicant's project involvement (including project activities, service opportunities, etc.).

Written Portion

- Consider the applicant's participation in the Armed Services, co-curricular activities, the applicant's academic achievement, leadership skills and your personal interactions with the applicant, as well as, your insights into his/her abilities, potential, and character.
- Indicate the applicant's impact on your project and other students and their potential vision to carry out the ideals of TRIO.

Formatting Guidelines

- 3. The personal essay and nominator recommendation **must follow the following formatting guidelines within Microsoft Word or PDF documents**. Any deviation from the formatting guidelines in the electronic document will cause a disqualification of the entire application packet.
 - Double spaced
 - 1 inch margins
 - 12 point font
 - Applicant's name at the top of each page
 - A maximum of 2 pages for the personal essay and a maximum of 1 page for the nominator written portion recommendation
- 4. The application packet must include a **current** transcript showing a cumulative GPA. Unofficial transcripts **will** be accepted.
- 5. All application materials become the property of MI-CAPP and will not be returned.

Applicant's Personal Essay: must be typed in Microsoft Word Document or PDF and meet the formatting guidelines.
