



ENDOWMENT AWARD INSTRUCTIONS

The MI-CAPP Education Foundation Committee presents the "Endowment Award" application packet for <u>both precollege and college-level</u> TRIO/EOP students. The committee may award **fourteen \$1000 awards** to selected students for your projects at the Student Leadership Summit Scholarship Banquet. Project Directors will register student scholarship recipients for the Full Saturday Feb.22 conference and ensure they attend the Student Leadership Summit Scholarship Banquet on that evening.

Project Directors, nominators, and readers must be MI-CAPP members by December 4, 2020.

Two categories of awards will be awarded: 1) **Academic Achievement Awards** designated for students who have weighted cumulative grade point averages of 3.2 and above, and 2) **Academic Progress Awards** designated for students whose weighted cumulative grade point averages are from 2.00-3.199.

Scholarship Award Distribution is as follows:

Academic Achievement: At Least 3.2 GPA

(4) Adult Learners Scholarships

Academic Progress: 2.00-3.199 GPA

Who can apply?

Pre-College: High school seniors who have been in the project for at least one year.

Adult Learners: In a TRIO project for at least one year.

Instructions

- 1. All application packets will be available in <u>electronic form only</u> on the MI-CAPP website <u>www.micapp.org</u>
- 2. Students/staff <u>must complete</u> the application packet electronically and submit via email by Friday, December 4, 2020.
- 3. All electronic application documents and supplemental materials: application, recommendation, essay, and the transcript must be emailed as **ONE** attachment to the MI-CAPP EFC email address <u>micapp</u>-scholarship@eoa.org
- 4. Any project submitting application packets must agree to designate at least one (1) reader <u>from its project.</u> Reader responsibilities are reading and scoring scholarships, submitting scores electronically, and participating in the reading meeting. *Virtual Reading day is Friday, January 15, 2021*.
- 5. To ensure inclusion in the Scholarship Banquet program booklet, if the applicant is selected, please be prepared to e-mail a jpeg photograph, and a 150-word bio to Yadira Bautista, micapp-scholarship@eoa.org as soon as notified of selection.
- 6. Directors will be notified of winners following the scholarship reading and board approval.
- 7. If an applicant's scholarship application packet is selected for an EOA Regional Scholarship, additional forms must be completed. Forms will be dispersed as needed later.

Applications will be disqualified if:

- 1. They are emailed after Friday, December 4, 2020.
- 2. MI-CAPP nominator's membership not active on Friday, December 4, 2020 (as verified by the EOA Registrar).
- 3. The Project Director does not sign (typed name is acceptable) the application.
- 4. The electronic application is edited from its original format.
- 5. The final application packet does not include all required documents.
- 6. The applicant is found to be ineligible for TRIO/EOP service, and admission date to the current program did not fall on or before the appropriate date. (December 4, 2019)
- 7. The applicant is not registered for the full Saturday Student Leadership Conference.



ENDOWMENT AWARD ESSAY GUIDELINES

- 1. The Applicant's Personal Essay should include the following information:
 - Personal and environmental obstacles the applicant overcame to pursue academic achievement or academic progress
 - Leadership the applicant has demonstrated in their TRIO/EOP project, school, family, and/or community
 - Service the applicant has given to the community, school, and/ or family
 - The final paragraph should state the single most important way in which TRIO/EOP
 has helped the applicant and describe what the applicant will do to demonstrate their
 commitment to TRIO/EOP
- 2. The Nominator's Recommendation should include the following information:

Evaluation Grid Portion

- Describe the applicant's academic achievement or academic progress
- Describe the applicant's project participation (including project activities, service opportunities, etc.)

Written Portion

- Describe the applicant's success in overcoming personal and environmental obstacles in pursuing academic achievement or maintaining academic progress.
- Describe the applicant's impact on the project, project staff and other project participants.

Formatting Guidelines

- 3. The Applicant's Personal Essay and Nominator Recommendation must follow the following formatting guidelines within Microsoft Word or PDF documents. Any deviation from the formatting guidelines in the electronic document will cause disqualification of the entire application packet.
 - Double spaced
 - 1-inch margins
 - 12-point font
 - Applicant's name at the top of each page
 - A maximum of 2 pages for the student essay and a maximum of 1 page for the nominator written portion of the recommendation
- 4. The application packet must include a **current** transcript (showing a cumulative weighted GPA). Unofficial transcripts **will** be accepted.
- 5. All application materials become the property of MI-CAPP and will not be returned.
- 6. If there are no applications eligible for one of the designated award categories, the Committee may grant the award to the next highest scoring qualified applicant from another category. Ultimately, it is at the discretion of the Education Foundation Committee and the Board on a yearly basis to decide if all scholarships will or will not be awarded once a category has been exhausted.
