

#### STUDY ABROAD INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

The MI-CAPP Education Foundation Committee presents the "Study Abroad Award" application packet for college <u>level</u> TRIO/EOP students. The committee may award two **\$1500 awards** to nominated students for your projects at the Student Leadership Summit Scholarship Banquet. Project Directors should assure that all applicants are included among delegates to the Student Leadership Summit so that they will be present at the Scholarship Banquet on February 27, 2021.

Project Directors, nominators, and readers must be MI-CAPP members by December 4, 2020.

Who can apply? Adult Learners: In a TRIO Program for at least one year.

### **Instructions**

- 1. All application packets will be available in <u>electronic form only</u> on the MI-CAPP website www.micapp.org
- 2. Students/staff <u>must complete</u> the application packet electronically and apply via email by Friday, December 4, 2020.
- 3. All electronic application documents and supplemental materials: application, recommendation, essay, and the transcript must be emailed as ONE attachment to the MI-CAPP EFC email address micapp-scholarship@eoa.org
- 4. Any project submitting application packets must agree to designate at least one (1) reader <u>from</u> <u>its project.</u> Readers responsibilities are reading and scoring scholarships, submitting scores electronically and participating in the reading meeting.
- 5. To ensure inclusion in the Scholarship Banquet program booklet, if the applicant is selected, please be prepared to e-mail a jpeg photograph, 150-word bio and EOA Photo Release to Yadira Bautista, micapp-scholarship@eoa.org as soon as notified of selection.
- 6. Directors will be notified of winners following the scholarship reading and board approval. Directors will be expected to submit the winner's jpeg photograph, 150-word bio and photo release at this time.
- 7. If an applicant's application is selected for an EOA Scholarship, additional forms must be completed. Forms will be dispersed as needed later.

# Applications will be disqualified if:

- 1. They are emailed after Friday, December 4, 2020.
- 2. MI-CAPP memberships not active on Friday, December 4, 2020 (as verified by the EOA Registrar).
- 3. The Project Director does not sign (the typed name is acceptable) the application.
- 4. The electronic application is edited from its original format.
- 5. The final application packet does not include all required documents.
- 6. The applicant is found to be ineligible for TRIO/EOP service, and admission date to the current program did not fall on or before the appropriate date. (December 4, 2019)
- 7. The applicant is not registered for the full Saturday Student Leadership Conference.



#### STUDY ABROAD SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- 1. The Applicant's Personal Essay is one of the most important parts of the application packet and should include the following information:
  - Why the applicant wants to study abroad
  - How the award will help support the applicant's study abroad opportunity
  - Why the study abroad location was chosen and how the experience will impact the applicant.
  - How the applicant will use or share information about study abroad and their crosscultural experiences when they return to the United States and a plan for presenting this information at a future TRIO conference.
  - The final paragraph should state the **single most important way in which TRIO/EOP has helped** the applicant and describe **what the applicant will do to demonstrate his/her commitment to TRIO/EOP**
- 2. The Nominator's Recommendation should include the following two-part information:

#### **Evaluation Grid Portion**

- Describe the applicant's readiness for study abroad.
- Describe the applicant's project participation (including project activities, service opportunities, etc.).

#### **Written Portion**

- Describe how the applicant's character and ability makes them stand out as the best study abroad candidate.
- Describe the applicant's impact on the project, project staff and other project participants.

# **Formatting Guidelines**

- 3. The personal essay and nominator recommendation **must follow the following formatting guidelines within Microsoft Word or PDF documents**. Any deviation from the formatting guidelines in the electronic document will cause a disqualification of the entire application packet.
  - Double spaced
  - 1 inch margins
  - 12 point font
  - Applicant's name at the top of each page
  - A maximum of 2 pages for the personal essay and a maximum of 1 page for the nominator written portion recommendation
- 4. The application packet must include a **current** transcript showing a cumulative GPA. Unofficial transcripts **will** be accepted.
- 5. All application materials become the property of MI-CAPP and will not be returned.



# STUDY ABROAD AWARD CHECKLIST

<b>Application:</b> must be <b>typed or hand written</b> in a Microsoft Word Document or PDF using the electronic form provided.
Nominator's Recommendation: must be typed in a Microsoft Word Document or PDF and meet the formatting guidelines.
Applicant's Personal Essay: must be typed in Microsoft Word Document or PDF and meet the formatting guidelines.
<b>Current Academic Official or Unofficial Transcript</b> from credit-granting institution showing current weighted cumulative grade point average (GPA).
<b>Application Packet</b> emailed by Friday, December 4, 2020 to <u>micapp-scholarship@eoa.org</u> .
Additional Information (if applicant is awarded)
<b>Jpeg</b> photograph and 150 word bio ready to e-mail to <a href="micapp-scholarship@eoa.org">micapp-scholarship@eoa.org</a> upon notification of selection.
If an applicant's scholarship application packet is selected for an EOA Regional Scholarship, additional forms must be completed. Forms will be dispersed as needed later.
